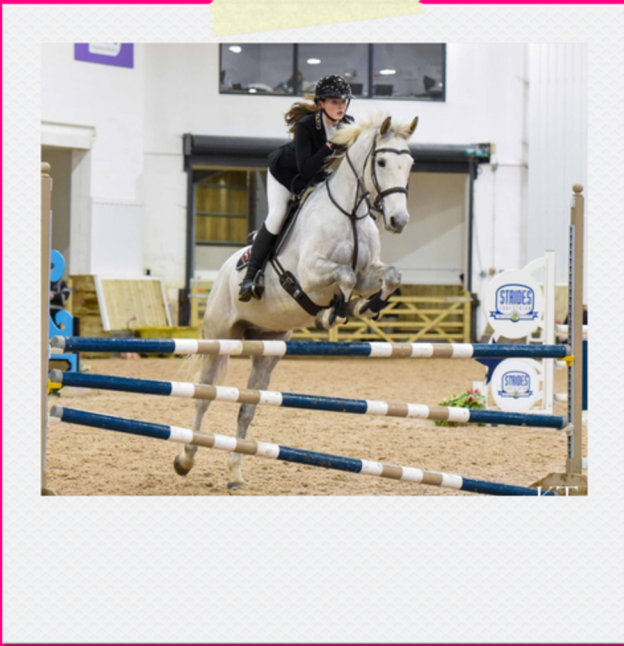
HOW DOES THE SENIOR UNAFFILIATED SHOWJUMPING SERIES WORK?

Our league system works through assigning points to the top 15 placings in each class, with the winner earning 15pts, 2nd 14pts and so on. These points accumulate through the winter season and the top 25 combinations are invited to battle it out in our championship show on Sunday 9th March where our Champions will be crowned!

Riders must participate in a minimum of 2 out of the 11 shows in the series qualify for a place in the league championships, the top 25 will be decided after the final date before the championship show.

Ineligibility of League Winners:
The winner of the league will not be eligible to compete in the same league in the following series. You are welcome to compete on the day however any points will be passed down. This rule aims to encourage fairness and equal opportunities for all competitors.

Additional Points Opportunity: The Championship show will have double points awarded!
