## Saturday 23rd August - Show Jumping PC70

Open to Teams and Individuals that have qualified at their Area Grassroots Show Jumping Competition. He competition will consist of 3 rounds jumped over a full course in two arenas. All teams to jump twice followed by a jump off against the clock if required – riders may NOT walk the 3<sup>rd</sup> round.

#### Withdrawals & Refunds

WITHDRAWALS (ALL COMPETITIONS & CHAMPIONSHIPS)

If a Branch or Centre withdraws a team or individual prior to the closing date for a competition, a full refund of entry and stabling fees will be made, less an administration charge. Withdrawals after the closing date for a competition will not be refunded for either competition or stabling.

ABANDONMENT (ALL COMPETITIONS & CHAMPIONSHIPS)

In the event of a competition being abandoned, for whatever reason, a refund of 50% of the entry fee will be given. In such an instance the refund process will be communicated and must be followed.

Prize giving will take place onsite at Kelsall Hill Equestrian Centre. Please note all competitors are required to attend prize giving in competition gear. Attending prize giving's are mandatory for each discipline. Prize giving's will be unmounted on the winner's podium.

Placings will be 1<sup>st</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> in all classes across the days of competition for both individuals and teams. Sashes will be presented to the individual winners and to each rider in the winning team in each discipline.

- Please ensure your members comply with eligibility, hat tagging, body protector and medical armband rules and there is a responsible adult present.
- Please wear your number bib and print your number from www.ponyclubresults.co.uk when times are issued. Bridle or saddlecloth on numbers are also permitted.
- Late entries may be accepted at the organiser's discretion. Late entry surcharge £5
- Queries may only be raised via the Secretary by the DC/Centre Proprietor or their appointee. Protests/objections will be managed as per the Rulebook.
- Photographic Rights competitors and their parents/guardians have given
  permission for any photographic and/or film or TV footage taken of persons or
  horses/ponies taking part in Pony Club events to be used and published in
  any media whatsoever for editorial purposes, press information or advertising
  by or on behalf of The Pony Club and/or Official Sponsors of The Pony Club.
- A valid passport and vaccination record must accompany the horse/pony to this event and must be available for inspection if required by event officials.
   Vaccinations must be in accordance with the Pony Club Vaccination Rule 2025.

The vets on call for the duration of the event will be Thomason and Harding Equine Vets. Should you require a vet please come into reception and notify a member of staff.

A farrier will be on call for the duration of the event. The farrier is to be confirmed. Should you require the farrier please come into reception and notify a member of staff.

# Additional Information: Stabling

Onsite stabling will be available on a first come first serve basis. We will have Cheval temporary stabling onsite. You are welcome to bring your own rubber matting. The price will be confirmed via the entry form. There is no turn out available with the stables. Stables must be paid for in full in prior to the competition.

A fully refundable stable cleaning deposit will be charged per stable, as long as the stable is returned to us clean and undamaged, a bare floor to bare floor policy is in place so please clean your stable out fully. Your stable cleaning deposit will be refunded to your card once it has been inspected by a member of our team. You will need to provide your own mucking out equipment, such as a brush and wheel barrow.

Bedding is available to purchase from the stable managers office; the price is £12 per bale. You are welcome to bring your own shavings if you wish.

Electricity hook up is available at £25 per unit per night. We do have a limited amount of hook ups available onsite. You will need to collect your hook up adaptor from the stable managers office, in office hours, with a £50 fully refundable deposit, refunded once you return the cable in working order.

To improve biosecurity, we do not have drinkers in the stables. You will need to provide your own bucket. There are taps for water located within the car parks around the stables.

You are welcome to bring your own forage onsite. Small bales of haylage/hay can be purchased via Equipe and collected from the Stable Managers Office at selected times.

Access to stabling is from 3pm until 6pm, stable to be fully emptied by 12pm on the day of departure. If you want to arrive late you will need to agree this in advance with the office prior.

No refunds on stabling or hook ups following Friday 15<sup>th</sup> August 2025.

# Camping:

Tents, caravans, trailers and lorries are all welcome to the event. Please note all over night stayers must be booked in advance, so we can account for all personal onsite. We do have onsite showers and toilets available 24/7.

# Catering:

Our catering onsite is provided by Urchin's Kitchen. The café is located in the equestrian centre providing both hot and cold refreshments and food throughout the day. Opening times will be confirmed, so people onsite will be able to have tea and breakfast prior to the competition.
