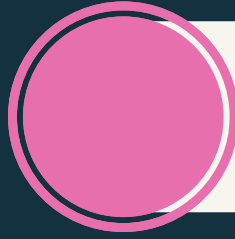

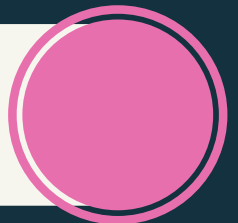

Competing in these classes are teams and individuals that have qualified at their Area Grassroots Show Jumping competition. Members of all ages with any size of horse or pony will be competing. Riders must never have represented their Branch or Centre at PC90 level or above in show jumping or eventing. The competition will consist of three rounds jumped over a full course in two arenas. All teams to jump twice followed by a jump off against the clock if required. Riders may NOT walk the third round.

Round 1 will take place in the Lake View Outdoor Arena and Round 2 and the jump off will take place in the JCL Insurance Brokers Grandstand Indoor Arena.

## STABLING

Onsite stabling will be available on a first come first serve basis. All stables will be Cheval Liberte star box stables. The stables are 12' x 12' and do not have rubber matting. You are welcome to bring your own rubber matting.

There is no turn out available with the stables. Stables must be paid for in full in prior to the competition.

A fully refundable stable cleaning deposit will be charged at £50 per stable, as long as the stable is returned to us clean and undamaged, a bare floor to bare floor policy is in place so please clean your stable out fully. Please ensure you bring cash along to pay the deposit to the stable manager prior to entering the stable.

Your stable cleaning deposit will be refunded once it has been inspected by the stable manager. You will need to provide your own mucking out equipment, such as a brush and wheel barrow.

Bedding is available to purchase from the office, the price is £12 per bale. You are welcome to bring your own shavings if you wish.

Electricity hook up is available at £25 per unit per night. We do have a limited amount of hook ups available onsite. You will need to collect your hook up adaptor from the office, in office hours, with a £50 fully refundable deposit, refunded once you return the cable in working order.

To improve biosecurity, we do not have drinkers in the stables. You will need to provide your own bucket. There are taps for water on the outside of the stable yard.

You are welcome to bring your own forage onsite. Small bales of haylage/hay is available to purchase from the stable managers office.

Check-in on the first day of stabling is from 3pm until 6pm, check-out (stable to be fully emptied) by 12pm on the day of departure. If you want to check in or out late please contact us before-hand.

# STAYING ON SITE...

**We have some basic rules to follow to ensure your health and safety whilst staying on site....**

**You can see from the plan on the previous page the location of the lorry, camping and car parks.**

- **No cars allowed in the lorry park**

Please follow this rule as failure to do so will mean we do not have enough space for lorries.

- **Barbecues are not allowed on site**

This is to ensure safety.

We do have urchins' kitchen open throughout the show!

- **Dogs on leads at all times**

We are dog friendly throughout our site including urchin's kitchen, however they must be on leads at all times and all dog mess must be picked up.

- **Generators, noise and behaviours**

We ask that generators are switched off by 11pm and after that noise is kept to a minimum.

- **Be sensible, kind and courteous**

Our staff and volunteers give up their time to ensure events can run. We do not accept any form of verbal or physical threats from anyone of any age.

- **All livery paddocks are out of bounds.**

- **Clear up all mess and leave the site as you found it**

Please use bins provided for all rubbish, do not litter the site and leave your area clean and tidy for next person. Please be mindful cattle may graze on the land and litter can be harmful to them.

- **Be fire safe**

Horseboxes should be equipped with fire extinguishers which are easily accessible by the driver.

- **Pushbikes are allowed for course walking.**

No cars are allowed on the course. Be horse aware at all times.

- **E scooters & E bikes are not allowed around the site. Anyone caught riding the above will have the bike confiscated .**

- **No swimming in the ponds at any point**

Anyone caught in the ponds will be sent home immediately.

## Welfare

### VETERINARY

For Saturday and Sunday we have a vet **on call**.

For eventing Monday we have a vet **on site**.

If you need veterinary assistance please come to reception or call 01829 708 241. The vets will be Thomason & Harding Equine Vets.

### BIOSECURITY

Biosecurity measures must be observed to prevent the spread of disease. [The Championships' Biosecurity Policy is available on The Pony Club website](#) and applies to ALL horses and ponies attending the Championships.

### PASSPORTS AND VACCINATIONS

Horse and ponies which are unvaccinated or whose vaccinations are not up to date pose a risk to the health of other animals attending the event. It is the responsibility of everyone who makes entries to the Championships to ensure that all vaccinations are up to date and that all ponies or horses travel with their passports.

The Pony Club rules require that an initial course of injections is given followed by boosters at intervals of not more than 12 months. No horse/pony can compete on the day of vaccination nor for the six subsequent days. All horses/ponies are liable to be checked for compliance, and anyone found arriving without a passport or with a non-compliant vaccination record will regrettably, but without exception, be required to leave the premises immediately and unable to compete.
